Stallholders and Patrons Canning Vale Sunday Market

The Perth Market Authority (PMA) manages the Market City complex on behalf of the WA Government. The current operator holds a licence to operate the Sunday Market in its current location (Western Buyers area) until early July 2011. This notice serves to clarify any potential misconceptions that members of the public may have about the future operation of the market.

PMA have decided that there will be no change to the current location at Market City during the term of the current licence. With effect from July 2011 a new facility in a new location will be made available at Market City to accommodate a Weekend Market. The need for this new location for the Weekend Market is brought about by the requirement for the PMA to provide uninhibited, safe and secure access for growers, retailers and wholesalers within the wholesale market 7 days a week. Whilst the Sunday Market has operated for a considerable period in the current location, there has been a growing need to free up the undercover area to cater for the fruit and vegetable industry.

To comply with proper government process the PMA intends to call for expressions of interest for the appointment of an operator of the Weekend Market. The current licensee will be invited to participate in this process.

In recognition of the role that the Canning Vale Sunday market concept plays in the community, the PMA board have agreed to construct a purpose built facility for the operation of the Weekend Market. It will cater for permanent and casual stall holders, giving flexibility to the number of days that the stall holder chooses to operate. At this point the Board has not made a decision on extending beyond a Weekend Market. The proposed new location and operation will not only benefit current stall holders and improve conditions for visitors, but importantly it will bring a greater focus to promotion and education about WA food, regional produce and community involvement in the Markets.
