

## What's Happening in the Sunday Markets

We have appointed a social media marketing and communications consultancy group to promote the Sunday Markets. In short the purpose of this campaign is to create additional awareness throughout the metro area and encourage new visitors/stall holders to attend on a regular basis. We are working through the implementation strategy of this campaign currently and will have more detail soon.

A new Liquid Food Waste Sink has been installed behind the "Pit Stop" kiosk for use by all food and beverage stall holders. The new sink is connected to a grease trap which is appropriate for disposing of these liquids. Please do not pour any waste liquids down the storm water drains in the ground as it causes environmental cleanup costs and is a breach of regulations.

Free WiFi for all Sunday Market visitors and stallholders for EFTPOS and/or EFT transactions and is nearly ready for use. The WAP - Wireless Application Protocol points and Login Page are currently being setup and configured which will be subject to testing in the next two (2) weeks.

The Online Booking system is currently being tested and uploaded with Monthly stall holder information prior to releasing the system for general use.

To enhance visitor and stall holder safety Improved Fencing has been installed around the perimeter of the Sunday Market to ensure the use of designated exit points. It's imperative that the correct entry and exit points are used to prevent accidents with other Market City operations being conducted on a Sunday.

As part of the traffic flow controls a new Central Toilet Crossing to access the Central Trading Area male/female toilets has been created. The crossing is located next to the "Pit Stop" kiosk - please wear the high-vis vests you will be handed and follow the white painted walkway to reach either the male or female toilets.

We are commencing a review of the "powered" bays usage it is expected in the coming weeks that PML staff will evaluate the usage of the non 15amp bays to assess whether or not that particular bay is being appropriately used. Should a stall be deemed to be using too much PML will offer an appropriate alternative option subject to availability.

### Stallholder Bays

Reminder to all stallholders to ensure that your stall/s are set up and your vehicles removed by 6:45am prior to the market opening to the public.

Stallholders are also reminded that vehicles are not to leave the bays until after the market is closed at 1:00pm and must be offsite no later than 3:00pm.

### City of Canning Food Permits & Regulations

Reminder to all food or beverage stallholders to ensure that you are compliant with the City of Canning's regulations and have the correct permits to trade. You must present these permits on request by any PML staff member.

### Waste Arrangements

PML would like to thank stall holders for the improved efforts on waste management. While there is still a level dumping occurring in the bins and boxes being left behind with waste inside as a group you have achieved a notable improvement. Please keep up the good efforts as it allows PML to focus on areas of growth rather than compliance.

Please ensure you bring adequate bins and bin liners to manage and remove your waste.
