PERTH MARKETS LIMITED (PML) B-DOUBLE TRUCK PARK TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AREA P

YOU MAY ONLY PARK IN A DESIGNATED B-DOUBLE TRUCK PARK IF YOU HOLD A VALID MARKET CITY ACCESS CARD AND A PML PARKING PERMIT.

TRIAL

Perth Market Limited (PML) are to trial dedicated parking of B-Double Trucks in AREA P, prior to the final configuration and permanent line marking of bays.

PML reserves its rights in its absolute discretion to modify or cancel at any time the trial procedure with a reimbursement of the remaining unused days of the annual fee to be paid to the PML parking permit license holder.

GENERAL

- 1 You enter and use this B-Double Truck parking facility at your own risk.
- 2 By entering and allowing your vehicle to remain in a designated B-Double Truck park, you consent to these terms and conditions of entry. If you do not accept these terms and conditions of entry, you must not enter the designated B-Double Truck park.
- 3 You must:
 - 3.1 only park your vehicle in designated bays that are appropriate for your vehicle and not park in any area which is not designated for your use;
 - 3.2 park your vehicle wholly within the appropriate marked bay; and
 - 3.3 comply with all parking signs, permit zones and directions issued to you by PML or its authorised officers.
- 4 Vehicles must not stay in excess of 24 hours without the approval of PML (otherwise they may be deemed as abandoned).

FAILURE TO COMPLY

- 5 Vehicles not complying with these B-Double Truck park terms and conditions of entry may be issued with a parking breach notice and PML will claim damages of \$50.00 from you.
- 6 PML or its authorised officers may direct the immediate removal of any vehicle from a B-Double Truck park in their sole discretion (acting reasonably).

WARNING: TOW AWAY AND WHEEL CLAMP AREA

In addition to any other rights at law, if you fail to comply with these terms and conditions of entry, your vehicle maybe;

- Towed to an impound facility; or
- Wheel clamped

At your expense.

If your vehicle is towed away and impounded or wheel clamped, you will be charged a fee for its release.

You must call (08) 9456 9215 to release your vehicle.

LIABILITY

- 7 PML is not responsible or liable for any of the following:
 - 7.1 injury to you or anybody else;
 - 7.2 damage to, destruction of, theft of or unauthorised delivery up of your vehicle or any other vehicle (authorised or not); or
 - 7.3 damage to, destruction of, theft of or delivery up of any property (including anything in or on your vehicle or any other vehicle) however caused.

INDEMNITY AND RELEASE

- 8 You indemnify and release PML in respect of any claim made against PML as a consequence of, in relation to, or in any way arising out of your use of this B-Double Truck park.

VISITORS

- 9 All visitors without an access card or parking permit must report to the Gate House at the Bannister Road entrance or go to PML reception.

OTHER

- 10 The PML Site Rules apply to all users of this B-Double Truck park and will form part of these terms and conditions of entry.
- 11 These terms and conditions of entry are in addition to any other terms and conditions that apply to your Market City access card or PML parking permit (as the case may be).
